



## Course Outline

The International Vascular Course is being held in The ASSERT Centre, College of Medicine & Health, UCC, Cork on the 1st & 2nd November 2018.

This course is geared towards vascular surgical trainees and practising vascular surgeons who wish to develop their skills in open dissection as well as endovascular procedures.

Participants will gain hands-on experience with open surgical dissection and reconstruction procedures on cadavers in our state-of-the-art purpose built facility. The simulated operating rooms feature integrated audiovisual facilities to allow for real time and post-procedure feed back from expert faculty. There will be 2-3 participants per cadaver.

Day 2 of the course will focus on endovascular procedures - Aortic and peripheral interventions ranging from basic to more challenging cases on Mentice Simulators.

Pre-course reading material will be provided.

- Abdominal Aorta
- Thoracic Aorta
- Femoral & Iliac Arteries
- Axillary Artery
- Endovascular Procedures
- Infrarenal Aneurysm Repair
- Thoracic Aneurysm Repair
- Superficial Femoral Artery Angioplasty
- Iliac Artery Angioplasty & Stenting
